#### 2. Project Summary

- (1) **Project Goals:** JDS(Before, this project name was “Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resource Development Scholarship”) Project targets the highly capable 18 young officials having status of civil/municipal servants who are expected to engage in implementing social and economic development plans as a future leader.

JDS Project offers 2-year Master's courses at Japanese Universities in English under following priority area. JDS Fellows will get a special opportunity for learning the forefront knowledge in Japan as well as for building the wide human networks with representatives of other countries.

- (2) **Background:** KYR experienced regime change twice after the collapse of the Soviet Union in 2005 and 2010. Consequently the country has lacked consistency and stability in its policies for correction of regional discrepancy and socio-economic development. The government has only an inadequate capacity for policy planning. Hence, KYR government needs to develop human resources who are expected to become leaders in KYR.

- (3) **Activities:**

Activities in Kyrgyzstan: Conduct advertisement and recruitment activities, collect and screen applications, hold technical and comprehensive selection of candidates, conduct orientation for selected candidates

Activities in Japan: Introduce with university life, track they learning process, other activities.

- (4) **Outputs:**

Output 1: Kyrgyz officials deeps their knowledge in particular sphere and obtain knowledge in best Japanese universities

Output 2: Kyrgyz officials communicate and strengthen networking with other countries representatives

Output 3: After arrival to Kyrgyzstan, they contribute to the enhanced bilateral relations between Kyrgyzstan and Japan.
